

NORTH END COMMUNITY – WHAT'S NOW, WHAT'S NEXT Community Engagement Report

In April 2015, North Hamilton Community Health Centre hosted the event “North End Community -- What’s Now, What’s Next” in an effort to reach a common understanding around changes happening in the neighbourhood.

We asked three questions, and here is what we heard:

NORTH END DEVELOPMENT-IMPACT ON INDIVIDUAL & COMMUNITY HEALTH

- Support the pace of change through good communication
- Ensure appropriate services remain in the neighbourhood
- Respond to the needs of residents who experience stress due to changes in the neighbourhood

WHAT IS A BALANCED NEIGHBOURHOOD

- Housing mix – affordable, subsidized, mixed housing styles
- Mixed incomes
- Trust amongst neighbours

INDIVIDUALS’ ROLE IN CREATING A BALANCED NEIGHBOURHOOD

- Provide a platform for input/community voice
- Support balanced neighbourhoods
- Engage local businesses and partners

Advocate for affordable housing in the community

Build partnerships with new businesses in the area

Create new programs
